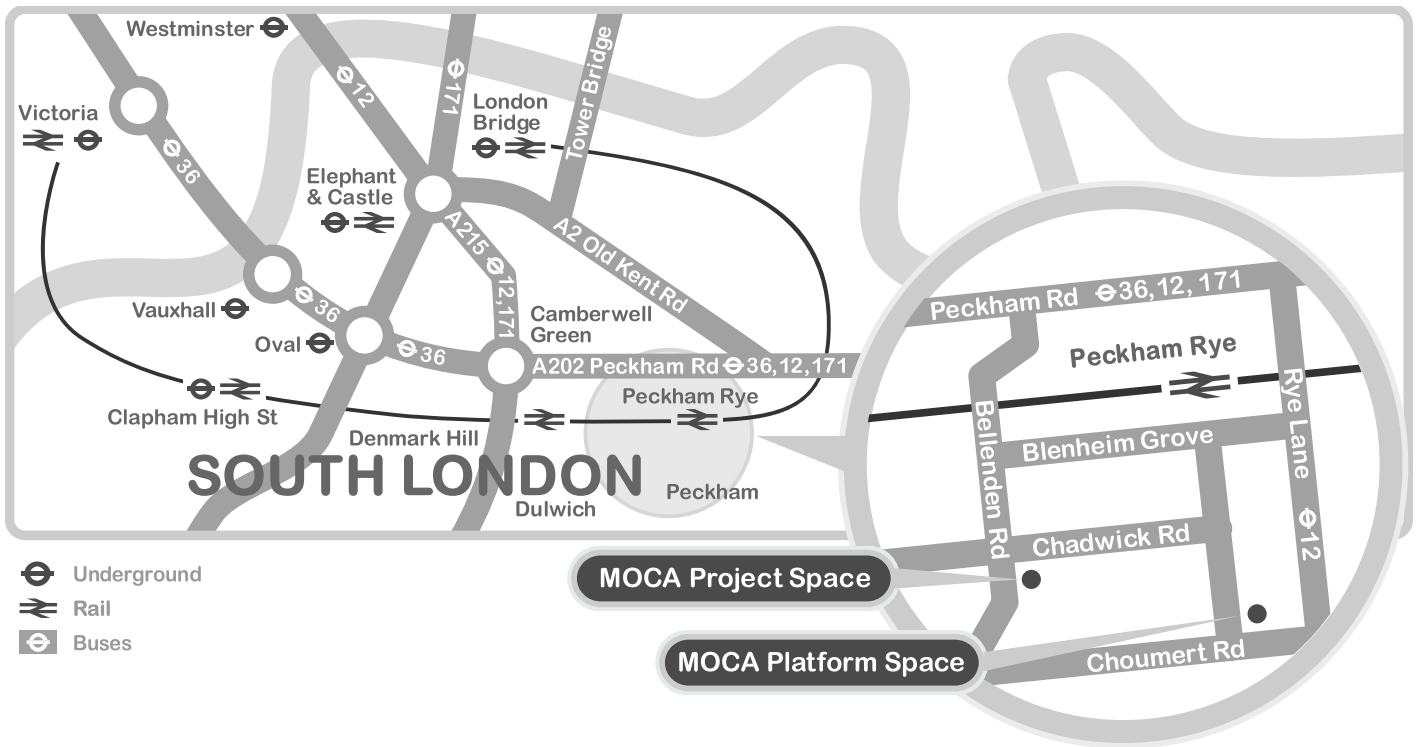

To find us: The nearest railway station is Peckham Rye, with frequent services from London Bridge and London Victoria. You can also get to MOCA on the buses 12, 36, 171.

From Elephant & Castle: Get a No 12 bus to Rye Lane.

From Vauxhall or Oval: Get a No 36 bus to Peckham High St.

From Algate or Waterloo: Get a 171 bus to Peckham High St.

Art in South London

There are plenty of museums and galleries in South London, and you could combine a visit to MOCA with one of the following;

The Tate Modern in the former Bankside Power Station, take a No 36 bus from Blackfriars Rd to Rye Lane (Peckham Rye BR Station).

The **South London Gallery**, just a 10 minutes walk away on Peckham Road next to the Camberwell College of Arts

The **Dulwich Picture Gallery** in Dulwich; take the No 37 bus from Rye Lane to North Dulwich Station or a train from Peckham Rye to North Dulwich.

The Horniman Museum in Forest Hill can be combined with MOCA by taking a No 37 bus and change on the 176 at Lordship Lane).
